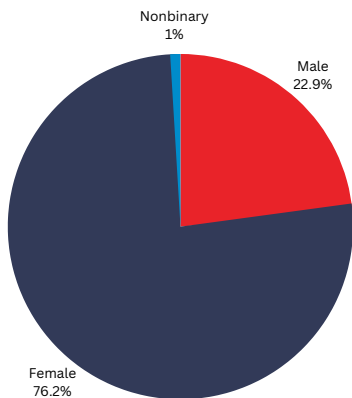

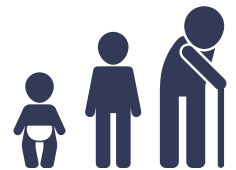

Moonshot was awarded the 2022 USDA Rural Development Grant which will allow for Pilot expansion into Winslow, AZ beginning May 1, 2023 and on the Pascua Yaqui Reservation, date to be determined.

BUDGET

Minimum annual budget needed for AZ Stitch Lab Tucson at its current program offering is **\$175,000** a year.

With additional an \$75,000 in funds (bringing the annual budget to \$250,000), AZ Stitch Lab will:

- Hire an AZ Stitch Lab Executive Director who oversees Tucson and statewide programs
- Create an AZ Stitch Lab Advisory Board, Tucson based
- Increase number of graduates to 140
- Increase number of class offerings to include digital pattern making and machine repair tech
